Elite Book Clubs

The cornerstone of Elite's pre-SAT academic enrichment is the Elite Book Club, designed to foster competency in all verbal skills. High School Admissions Test Prep Course

Students applying to Lowell or a private high school in the San Francisco Bay Area will have to take the SSAT, HSPT, or STAR test as part of the admissions process. This course, modeled after our SAT prep courses, consists of a weekly practice test, an in-class test review, and lectures in Reading, Grammar, and Math. **These classes will begin the week of Sept. 15 and will be held at the Irving branch.**

College Application Workshops
