SAT Reasoning Courses (SAT I)

June 21, 2010: SUMMER SESSION BEGINS for SAT Classes.

Summer is the ideal time to start preparing for the SAT, and Elite offers many options for ambitious students. Elite's summer classes begin June 21, 2010.

Morning Boot Camp classes are our most effective summer programs. Students meet from morning to early afternoon, Monday through Friday, for 8 weeks.

Afternoon Boot Camp classes meet five days a week from 2 PM to 6:30 PM. These intensive classes are a good choice for students who have summer school or other summer activities.

2100 Plus classes continue for 14 weeks, rather than 8 weeks, and are offered to students who meet certain minimum requirements.
