### SAT Morning Boot Camp

Elite's famous SAT Boot Camp is a demanding program designed for high school students of all levels who want to commit most of their summer to raising their SAT scores. Students take a weekly 3.5-hour practice test every Monday and attend approximately 4.5 hours of class and test review Tuesday through Friday developing **critical reading, grammar, vocabulary, writing, and math** skills.
