**Course Description** The **2100 Goal & Plus Program** is extremely rigorous 15-week SAT test preparation program that requires many hours of out-of-class work and preparation. This program is designed for high school students at the top of their game who successfully take AP and honors classes at their high schools and want to round out their college applications with truly outstanding test scores. **Only the students who satisfy minimum academic and test score requirements can enroll.**

## SAT Weekday \*\*\*

**Course Description** The **Elite Summer Weekday SAT Program** is an afternoon program designed for students who will be enrolled in summer school classes at their high school and yet want to take an intensive SAT preparation program during summer, emphasizing the development of critical reading skills. Students meet for a total of about 11 ½ hours per week – 3 days per week for 4 hours each day.

## SAT Boot Camp \*\*\*\*\*

**Course Description** The **Elite SAT Boot Camp** is a very demanding program designed for high school students who want to commit most of their summer to raising their SAT scores. In the 8-week SAT Boot Camp, students will take weekly 3 hour and 30 minute practice tests, study 2,000 vocabulary words, analyze dozens of college-level articles and essays, and write numerous essays that will be scored by instructors.

**Course Description** The **Elite Summer Weekend SAT Program** offers students a basic package of four interlocking classes: a critical reading class, a math class, a writing class, and a practice test session. Students meet for a total of about 9 ½ hours per week—each of the weekly classes meets for 2 hours and the practice test lasts for 3 hours and 30 minutes.
