## SAT COURSE SCHEDULE SUMMER 2010 (June 21 – August 14)

### 2100 Program

The **2100 Program** is a rigorous, 15-week course that requires many hours of in-class and out-of-class work. This class is offered to self-motivated students with a strong background in AP and Honors classes. Classroom time is 11.5 hours per week during the summer. Continuing fall classes (and optional office hours) include 8 hours of classroom time, offered on Fridays or on Saturdays. *Enrollment is dependent upon meeting minimum academic and test score requirements.*

### SAT – Weekend

### How to Register

Enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis. **New Students** must take a free diagnostic test or provide recent official College Board PSAT / SAT scores in order to be placed into the appropriate class. There is a \$ non-refundable registration fee for first time enrollments.

### SAT AM Bootcamp

The **Elite SAT AM Boot Camp** is a demanding program designed for high school students who want to commit most of their summer to raising their SAT scores. In this 8-week program, students will take a weekly 3.5 hour practice test, study over 2,000 vocabulary words, analyze dozens of college-level articles and essays, and write numerous essays subsequently scored and critiqued by Elite instructors. Students attend class from 8:30 am to 1:00 pm Monday through Friday. Classroom time is 21.5 hours per week (22.5 hours per week for the 2100 Bootcamp). Optional continuation classes are offered in the fall as a "bridge" to the October SAT exam.

## JR. ELITE COURSE SCHEDULE SUMMER 2010 (June 21 – August 14)

***Elite's PSAT and Jr. Elite programs seek to build a strong foundation for future SAT and university-level study. We encourage reading, thinking, and participating, rather than mindless memorization and drill. Students entering 5<sup>th</sup> through the 8<sup>th</sup> grade improve fundamental skills through reading, grammar, writing and (optional) math work, while our 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> graders in PSAT programs become familiar with the format and underlying concepts of the SAT and PSAT exams.***

### BOOK CAMP

Elite **Elementary Enrichment** classes, intended for students about to enter grades 5 and 6, are kept small to foster confidence and participation. The academic emphasis is on reading, writing, and some initial work on critical thinking and analysis. Elite's Book Club ensures that students gain valuable contact with literature. Most classes complete a book every 3-4 weeks.
