The 2100 Goal Program

An extremely rigorous 16-week course that requires many hours of out-of-class work and preparation, Elite's 2100 Goal Program is designed for academically high-achieving students who want to round out their college applications with truly impressive test scores. Enrollment is selective and based on minimum diagnostic test scores and academic requirements. This course includes a 3.5-hour practice test and 8 hours of test review and classroom instruction per week during the eight weeks of summer. In the six weeks of the fall, class time is reduced to 4.5 hours on Saturday, though students continue to take the weekly practice test on Fridays, after school.

SAT Morning Boot Camp

Elite's famous SAT Boot Camp is a very demanding program designed for high school students of all levels who want to commit most of their summer to raising their SAT scores. Students take a weekly 3.5-hour practice test and attend 4.5 hours of classes and test review Tuesday through Friday, developing critical reading, grammar, vocabulary, writing, and math skills. Diagnostic test scores are used to place students into the appropriate class for their level.

SAT Afternoon Boot Camp

This is a modified version of the Morning Boot Camp, designed to accommodate students who have summer school or other commitments in the morning. The class meets four times a week in the afternoon, Monday through Thursday, with weekly 3.5-hour practice test and 4.5 hours of classes and test review.

SAT Weekday (WD)

Designed for flexibility, our Weekday SAT course is able to accommodate a variety of summer schedules. Students take a 3.5-hour practice test every Monday and attend class for 8 hours: two days a week, 4 hours each meeting.

SAT Weekend (WE)

Elite's Weekend SAT course is a good option for students who have a full schedule of commitments or summer school during the week yet still want to prepare for the SAT in the fall. Students take a 3.5-hour practice test every Friday and attend class for 6 hours on Saturdays, with a 45-minute break for lunch.

HOW TO REGISTER

Enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis. To ensure an effective teaching environment, Elite caps enrollment at 15 students per class, and summer classes typically reach maximum capacity. Please register early to avoid the last-minute rush. A tuition deposit of 50% will be required to reserve a space in class. New students will need to take a free diagnostic test in order to be placed into the appropriate class.

Book Camp (Morning)

Elite's Book Camps utilize contemporary works of literature in a classroom setting to hone vocabulary, critical reading skills, and grammar, and to practice writing in various genres. Students must take a diagnostic test for placement into the appropriate level. Book Camp students will complete about one book a week over the summer as well as analyze essays and other non-fiction texts. Practice problems from standardized tests (e.g. PSAT) administered in class throughout the summer will assist in measuring students' progress.

Math Clinic

Employing more than mere rote memorization, Elite's Math Clinics are designed to help students master concepts and problem-solving techniques. Each class presents the principles appropriate to a specific math level in a clear format. The students then apply these math principles to exercises developed to sharpen problem-solving skills and reinforce understanding. A discount is offered when students take a math clinic in conjunction with a Book Camp or Book Club.

Writing Clinic

Elite's new Writing Clinic will teach students how to construct effective thesis statements and topic sentences; how to organize their thoughts into coherent paragraphs; how to vary sentence structure and enliven their writing; and how to spot good writing techniques and incorporate them into their own style. Students will cover expository, persuasive, and narrative genres. Essays are assigned in class and for homework and are thoroughly critiqued in peer editing reviews and commented on extensively by the instructors.
