AP Course

Take the AP course during the summer or school year

02

Service Project

Plan & carry out the service project addressing a local and global issue

03

Exam & Portfolio

Take the AP exam in May and submit your service portfolio

Building a fuel cell to provide electrical energy to areas affected by natural disasters



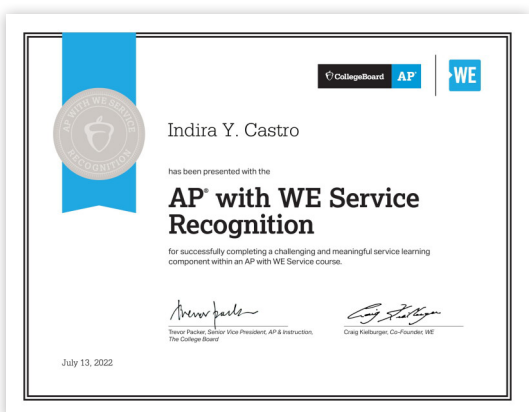
